Those who know your name trust in you. Psalm 9:10

Scripture gives us the gift of knowing Jesus not only through what He said and did, but also through His many names. Names identify someone, and reflect that person's character. This week as we listen and talk to God in prayer, we will be focusing on one of Jesus' names each day. The list below provides some additional names of Jesus that you can pray through during the week or in the weeks to come. Use the questions on the back to interact with these names.

Good Shepherd: I am the Good Shepherd. I know my own and my own know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I lay down my life for my sheep. John 10:14-15

Light: I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life. John 8:12

The Way: I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father expect through me. John 14:6

Cornerstone: The stone which the builders refused has become the cornerstone. Psalm 118:22

Truth: The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us. We have seen His glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth. John 1:14

Lord: Therefore God exalted Him to the highest place and gave Him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Philippians 2:9-11

Beloved Son: And a voice from heaven said, "This is my beloved Son and I am wonderfully pleased with Him. Matthew 3:17

True Vine: I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. John 15:5

Rock: ...be my rock of refuge, a strong fortress to save me. Since you are my rock and my fortress, for the sake of your name lead and guide me. Psalm 31:2b-3.

Redeemer: Praise the Lord, my soul; all my inmost being, praise His holy name. Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all His benefits; who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion, who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagles. Psalm 103:1-5

Shelter: I love you Lord, my strength. The Lord is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer; my God is my rock, in who I take refuge, my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold. Psalm 18:1-2

Advocate: My dear children I write this to you so that you will not sin. But is anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father-Jesus Christ, the Righteous One. He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world. 1 John 2:1-2

Potter: Yet you Lord, are our Father. We are the clay and you are the potter; we are all the word of your hand. Isaiah 64:8

Mediator: I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people.... This is good, and pleases God our Saviour, who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth. For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself as a ransom for all people. 1 Timothy 2:1, 3-7

Lamb of God: Look! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. John 1:29

And in that body God declared an end to sin's control over us by giving his Son as a sacrifice for our sins. Romans 8:3
