Who is the light and does this predict His death? How do we become children of light who live in relationship with Jesus?</p>	<p>31 <i>Life of Jesus - Matthew 26:6-16</i> (Holy Wednesday) Why does Jesus say she has done a beautiful thing when it seems like a waste? What did I learn about Jesus from this? How does this relate to my relationship with Jesus?</p>	<p>Apr 1 <i>Life of Jesus - John 13, 18, 19:1-16</i> (Maudy Thursday) As you read through the last day of Jesus' life before He was crucified, what stood out to you? How does this relate to your relationship with Jesus?</p>	<p>2 <i>Life of Jesus - Luke 23:1-56</i> (Good Friday) If Jesus is God, why did He stay on the cross? What do you think He was feeling in that moment? What does Jesus' choice say about His love for you? How will you respond?</p>	<p>3 <i>Life of Jesus - Matthew 27:62-66</i> (The Forgotten Day) Why were the religious leaders the only ones concerned about Jesus rising again? When our feelings make us doubt God's promises, does God still keep His promises?</p>
<p>4 <i>Life of Jesus - John 20:1-30</i> (Easter Sunday - CHRIST IS RISEN!) What was Mary's response when she encountered the resurrected Jesus? What was Thomas's response? How will you respond to our resurrected Jesus?</p>	<p>5 <i>After Resurrection - Luke 24:13-34</i> Why do you think Jesus is slow to reveal Himself? How has Jesus been present for you even when you didn't realize it? Why did Jesus patiently explain how all of God's Story points to Him?</p>	<p>6 <i>After Resurrection - John 20:24-31</i> Where are you, like Thomas, focused on requiring proof from God and missing His joy? What does Jesus' actions toward Thomas show us about his love and patience towards us?</p>	<p>7 <i>After Resurrection - Matthew 28:16-20</i> What three things are followers of Jesus commissioned to do? How does it make you feel that Jesus promises He is always with you? How does this impact your approach towards His commission?</p>	<p>8 <i>After Resurrection - Acts 1:6-11</i> What does it mean to be a witness for Jesus? What changes in a person when they receive the Holy Spirit? How can you depend on the Holy Spirit to be a witness for Jesus today?</p>	<p>9 <i>After Resurrection - Acts 2:42-47</i> What stands out about the way that these Jesus- followers lived their lives? Why did they live this way? What does it look like for you to live your life focussed on serving your family, friends, and church?</p>	<p>10 Take this day to take time to catch up on your reading, pray, rest in God's presence and prepare for tomorrow's activity.</p>
<p>11 <i>Healing Imperfections Ephesians 1:1-10</i> What makes you loved, chosen, and part of God's family? How does Christ's sacrifice make us free? How does this freedom help us forgive the people in our lives?</p>	<p>12 <i>Ephesians 1:11-14</i> Who do we belong to? How do we find out who we are and what our purpose is? What promises do we have in Jesus? Take some time today to praise God for all these things.</p>	<p>13 <i>Ephesians 1:15-23</i> Where does Christ sit today? What does this show us about God's power? How can we know and encounter God's hope? Who can you thank God for today and pray over?</p>	<p>14 <i>Ephesians 2:1-7</i> What does it mean to be dead in our trespasses and sins? What does it mean to be made alive in Christ? Why does God choose to give us new life even in our brokenness?</p>	<p>15 <i>Ephesians 2:8-9</i> What is grace? What is faith? What are works? What does it mean we are saved by grace through faith - and not from works? Have you accepted God's gift of salvation? Spend time praying thanking God for this gift!</p>	<p>16 <i>Ephesians 2:10</i> What does it mean to be God's creation? What works do you think God has created you to do? How can you share this message of love and hope with those around you? Ask God today how you can work for Him.</p>	<p>17 Take this day to take time to catch up on your reading, pray, rest in God's presence and prepare for tomorrow's activity.</p>
<p>18 <i>New Copernicans Ephesians 2:11-13</i> Where do you see hopelessness in the world? Does this lead you to question God? How so? What does it mean to be brought near to God? How does God give you hope?</p>	<p>19 <i>Ephesians 2:14-17</i> What does it mean to be unified? Why and how does Christ bring unity? What does it mean that Christ is our peace? How have you experienced the peace of God?</p>	<p>20 <i>Ephesians 2:18-22</i> Who do we have access to through Christ? How does this unify us? What does it mean that Christ is the cornerstone? How can we grow together in unity - what is our role?</p>	<p>21 <i>Ephesians 3:1-6</i> Paul speaks of God revealing His grace to Him - how has God revealed His love to you? Where in your life do you see evidence of God (revelation)? Thank God for the way He reveals Himself!</p>	<p>22 <i>Ephesians 3:7-13</i> The Holy Spirit empowers us to do God's Work - have you ever felt more confident or bold because of God? Share your story. What happens when others see God work in and through your life?</p>	<p>23 <i>Ephesians 3:14-19</i> If someone were to ask you to explain how much God loves you - what would you say? Take time, just as Paul did, and pray for someone you know who is discouraged or fearful.</p>	<p>24 Take this day to take time to catch up on your reading, pray, rest in God's presence and prepare for tomorrow's activity.</p>
<p>25 <i>Spiritual Mismatches Ephesians 3:20-21</i> Do you pray bold prayers believing God is able? Why or why not? Take time to pray boldly today for something on your heart. Think of someone in your life who does not know Jesus - pray boldly for their salvation.</p>	<p>26 <i>Ephesians 4:1-6</i> What does Paul say are attitudes of a "life worthy of the calling?" What attitude in your life requires growth? Pray together that you would experience growth and therefore unity! What unifies all believers?</p>	<p>27 <i>Ephesians 4:7-16</i> Why were we given Spiritual gifts? What gifts do you believe you have? Take the time to identify gifts in one another. How are we to speak truth? How does this help us grow to be like Jesus?</p>	<p>28 <i>Ephesians 4:17-24</i> What does it mean to take off our old self? Why is this something we are to do when we encounter God's love? How does God's love change us? Why should we, as believers, have a different attitude?</p>	<p>29 <i>Ephesians 4:25-30</i> In pursuit of our new life in Christ, what are we to take off, and what are we to put on? What is our motivation in living our new life? Reflect and pray together over how you can be more like Jesus.</p>	<p>30 <i>Ephesians 4:31-32</i> What power does our words hold? Share a time you were hurt, or hurt someone, with your words - and a time you were kind, or someone was kind to you? How did you feel during these conversations? How can you forgive others, like Christ has forgiven you?</p>	<p>May 1 Take this day to take time to catch up on your reading, pray, rest in God's presence and prepare for tomorrow's activity.</p>
